CHAP. 28

An Act to amend article 4367 of the Revised Statutes, 1909
respecting the erection and division of parishes and the
building and repair of churches, parsonages and cemeteries
and respecting *fabriques*.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legis-
lative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Que-
bec, enacts as follows :

R.S.Q., 4367, 1. Article 4367 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended
amended. by adding thereto the following paragraph :

Certain " For the purposes of this chapter a Roman Catholic apos-

tolie vicariate, canonically erected and recognized in the Province by ecclesiastical authority, shall be considered as a diocese, and the incumbent thereof as being the bishop of a diocese.”

CHAP. 29

An Act to insert article 4491a in the Revised Statutes, 1909

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following article is inserted in the Revised Statutes, 1909, after article 4491 : R. S. Q., 4491a, enacted.

“**4491a.** The General Council of the Bar shall, in the month of March of each year, send, by registered letter, to the secretary of each section, a statement of the financial situation of the General Corporation of the Bar on the 1st day of January, previous.” Sending of financial statement to sections.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CHAP. 30

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes, 1909, respecting corpses that may be made use of for the study of anatomy

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 4884 of the Revised Statutes, 1909, is amended by inserting after the word : “inclusively” in the eighth line, the words “or that they represent the Last Post Imperial Naval and Military Contingency Fund, if the deceased was an old soldier or sailor of the Imperial army or of the Canadian troops.” R. S. Q., 4884, amended.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
