

An Act to erect the School Municipality of the village of
Ayer's Cliff.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

WHEREAS, Albertus E. Fish, trader ; Charles W. Vaughan, blacksmith ; Reverend Churchill Moore; Cecil L. Brown, physician ; John Hibbard, railroad employee, and Leon L. Clough, mill owner, all of the village of Ayer's Cliff, have, by petition, prayed for the erection of the territory comprising the municipality of the village of Ayer's Cliff into a school municipality, for all school purposes, under the name of " The School Commissioners of the Municipality of the Village of Ayer's Cliff " ;

Whereas, the rate-payers of said municipality have already organized as a school board, and the petitioners desire that the election of such board, and the acts thereof, be sanctioned ;

And whereas, it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The territory comprised within the limits of the mu-Territory af-

as of date July 1st, 1909.

2. The election of the board of school commissioners for Certain elec-

municipality, and entitled to hold office as such in the same
manner as though the said school municipality had been legally
erected on or before the 1st day of July, 1909.

3. All acts done and performed by said school commission-Certain acts
ers, including the assessment for school taxes levied by them, confirmed.
which would have been valid if the said school municipality
had been legally erected, are hereby declared valid and are
ratified and confirmed.

4. The said school municipality shall be subject to the Education
