

CHAP. 119

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Stephen Langevin to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

WHEREAS Stephen Langevin of the city of Montreal, in the district of Montreal, has, by his petition represented:— Preamble.

That on 7th June, 1909, he obtained a diploma of doctor of medicine from Laval University after having duly followed the regular lectures of the medical faculty of the said university during the period fixed by law;

That he began to follow the lectures of the medical faculty of the said university before having obtained his admission to study, which he obtained on the 21st September, 1909, from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec;

That he is qualified to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics, but that he cannot obtain his license to practise the same until he has completed his four years of study as a medical student;

That he has obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to the passing of an act to authorize the said College to grant him the necessary license to practise his profession;

And whereas he has prayed that an act be passed to that effect and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:—

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Stephen Langevin among its members and to grant him the necessary license to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in the Province. College of P. and S., P. Q., authorized to admit S. Langevin.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
