

CHAP. 121

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit François Louis Demers, to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

WHEREAS François Louis Demers of the city of Montreal, **Preamble.** has, by his petition represented:—

That on the 11th June, 1909, he obtained a diploma of Doctor of Medicine from Laval University in Montreal;

That he began to follow the lectures of the medical faculty of the said university before having obtained his admission to study, which he obtained on the 7th July, 1909, from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec;

That he is qualified to practise medicine, but that he cannot obtain his license to practise until he has completed his four years of study as a medical student;

That he has obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to the passing of an act to authorize the said College to grant him his license;

And whereas he has prayed that an act be passed to that effect and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said François Louis Demers among its members and to grant him the necessary license to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this Province.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
