

CHAP. 125

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Samuel Ortenberg to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics.

[Assented to 4th June, 1910]

WHEREAS Samuel Ortenberg, of the city of Quebec, has, Preamble.
by his petition, represented:

That on the twelfth of June, 1908, he obtained a diploma of Doctor of Medicine from McGill University, in Montreal, after having duly followed the regular lectures of the said school during the time fixed by law;

That he began to follow the lectures of the said school before having obtained his admission to the study of medicine;

That since then, he has obtained from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, after having passed the necessary examinations, his certificate of admission to the study of medicine, and that he was duly admitted to the study of medicine by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, on the twenty-seventh of September, 1905;

That he is qualified to practice medicine, surgery, and obstetrics, but that he cannot obtain his license to practice until he has completed his four years of study as a medical student;

That he has obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to the passing of an act to authorize the said College to grant him the license required to practice his profession;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Samuel Ortenberg and S., P. Q. among its members and to grant him the necessary license to practice medicine, surgery, and obstetrics in this Province. authorized to admit S. Ortenberg.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
