## CHAP. 22

An Act to validate certain deeds of transfer of the property  
of successions subject to succession duty

[Assented to 1st April, 1909]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legis-  
lative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec,  
enacts as follows :

**1.** All deeds transferring the ownership of the property of Certain deeds  
successions, made and passed since the twenty-fourth day of ratified.  
June, eighteen hundred and ninety two, are valid, notwithstand-  
ing that the duties imposed under the law relating to duty upon Proviso.  
successions, were not paid till after the date on which such deeds  
were passed, or have not yet been paid, provided, in the latter  
case, the said duties be paid within the sixty days following  
the coming into force of this act.

**2.** This act shall not affect pending cases, nor the acquired Pending  
rights of third parties. cases, &c.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into  
force.
