An Act to amend the Revised Statutes respecting special provisions applicable to cities, towns and other corporations

[Assented to 29th May, 1909.]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Revised Statutes are amended by adding the following section and articles to chapter second of title eleventh :

“ SECTION XI

“ CONTRIBUTION BY MUNICIPALITIES TO PROTECTION OF
APPROACHES TO RAILWAY CROSSINGS

“ **4650d.** The council of any city, town or other municipal corporation, however incorporated and notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special act incorporating or applying to such corporation, may pass a by-law or by-laws providing for the contribution by such municipal corporation to the expense of safeguarding, whether by the erection of gates, or the construction of tunnels or over-head bridges, or other like devices, the approaches to a railway which crosses on the level any public road within the municipality; and may for the purposes of such contribution, by the same or by another by-law, borrow money and issue the bonds or debentures of the corporation therefor.

“ **4650e.** No by-law mentioned in this section shall be subject to the approval of the municipal electors of the municipality, but the same shall otherwise be subject to the law respecting such a by-law in force in the municipality.”

Coming into
force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
