

CHAP. 70

An Act to amend article 1220 of the Civil Code respecting proof
by writings

[Assented to 29th May, 1909]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1220 of the Civil Code, as amended by the act 62 C.C., art. 1220 Victoria, chapter 49, section 1, is further amended by adding ^{amended.} the following paragraph :

“ 8. In the county of Gaspé, any copy delivered by the ^{Certain} prothonotary, of any power of attorney executed out of the ^{writings au-} Province of Quebec, in presence of one or more witnesses and ^{thentic in} authenticated before any mayor or other public officer of the ^{district of} country where it bears date, such copy being taken from the ^{Gaspé.} original deposited and kept in his office among the records of the Superior Court.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into} force.

CHAP. 71

An Act to amend the Civil Code respecting privileges upon
moveable property

[Assented to 29th May, 1909]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2006 of the Civil Code, as amended by the act 59 C.C., art. 2006 Victoria, chapter 41, section 2, is further amended by adding ^{amended.} after the word “clerks” in the first line of the second paragraph the words : “commercial travellers.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into} force.
