An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting decency and good morals

[Assented to 29th May, 1909]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Municipal Code is amended by inserting the following article after article 606 :

“ **606a.** To prohibit any building or part of a building situated within such distance as the by-law may prescribe from any church or other building used habitually for purposes of public worship, being used as an inn, a restaurant, a liquor shop, a bowling-alley, or a place to which the public is admitted for the purpose of dancing or engaging in any noisy game or amusement.”

Municipal Code, art. 606a, added. To prohibit certain buildings being used as inns, &c.

C H A P . 78

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting the supplying of gas or electricity

[Assented to 7th May, 1909]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following article is inserted in the Municipal Code after article 640*i*, as enacted by the act 52 Victoria, chapter 54, section 13.

“ **640j.** To exercise all the powers conferred upon it by this section, whenever it thinks fit to supply or cause to be supplied, the municipality or any part thereof, with gas or electricity for lighting, heating, or power purposes.”

Mun. Code, art. 640j, enacted.

Exercise of certain powers re supply of gas, &c.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
