An Act to amend article 716 of the Municipal Code respecting the making of the valuation roll

[Assented to 29th May, 1909]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

amended.

1. Article 716 of the Municipal Code, as the same is contained in article 6148 of the Revised Statutes, and as amended by the acts 60 Victoria, chapter 57, section 5, and 3 Edward VII, chapter 60, section 7, is further amended by striking out the words “ of Gaspe and in that of ”, in the first line of the second paragraph.

Coming into

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P . 80

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Quebec

[Assented to 29th May, 1909]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the city of Quebec has, by its petition, represented that it is necessary to amend its act of incorporation, and it is expedient to grant its prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

City of Quebec authorized to enter into certain ferry contract.

1. Without prejudice to the act 29 Victoria, chapter 57, section 29, paragraphs 73, 76, 77, as amended by the act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 50, sections 1 and 2, and by the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 49, section 24, the city of Quebec is authorized to enter into an agreement or contract with the corporation of the town of Levis to provide for the purchase or lease by such corporations, of vessels for establishing under their control and administration a ferry service over the River St. Lawrence, between the city of Quebec and the town of Levis, during the periods of time to be agreed upon between them and on such conditions as may be stipulated between them by by-laws or resolutions to be adopted by each of them respectively and for all purposes connected with such ferry.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of the act 7 Edward VII, ^{Duration of} chapter 46, the sale of the exclusive right of ferrying between ^{exclusive} the said city, and the town of Levis mentioned in the first ^{ferry grant.} paragraph of section 2 of the act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 50 may be for a period not exceeding fifteen years.

3. For the fulfilment of the objects set forth in section 1, the ^{Loan for such} city of Quebec is authorized to procure a sum not exceeding ^{purpose.} two hundred and fifty thousand dollars by means of an issue ^{Bonds, &c.} of bonds or debentures which may be issued by it from time to time or at the same time, in such manner as may be determined by the council of such city, and to create such sinking funds as may be required for that purpose. Such bonds or debentures may be made redeemable in fifty years or sooner.

4. The municipal council of the said city is authorized to ^{By-laws re-} pass a by-law to order that in certain parts of the city or in ^{gulating} certain streets or parts of streets, houses or other buildings ^{building of} shall be built in the manner prescribed by such by-law as ^{houses, &c.} regards symmetry, materials, the rules of solidity and hygiene, protection against fire and other objects.

5. Paragraph 7 of article 33 of the act 29 Victoria, chapter ^{29 V., c. 57,s.} 57, is replaced by the following : ^{33 amended.}

" 7. No gallery, window, portico, staircase or other obstruc- ^{Prohibition} tion shall extend or project from any house or building into ^{of projecting} or beyond the line of any street, lane, road or public place ^{galleries, &c.} in the said city otherwise than in such manner as may be prescribed and permitted by the by-laws of the municipal council of the said city.

6. Notwithstanding the act 57 Victoria, chapter 58, sections ^{Materials} 16 and 17, the municipal council of the city may pass a by-law ^{with which} to permit the facing of certain houses or parts of houses or ^{buildings} other buildings with incombustible materials other than brick. ^{may be faced.}

7. The said council may also, by by-law, order the closing, ^{Sunday} throughout Sunday, of theatres, moving pictures or other ^{closing of} shows or entertainments to which the public is admitted. ^{theatres, &c.}

8. If a majority of the rate-payers residing in any part of ^{Removal of} the city ask the city council to adopt measures for the removal ^{garbage by} of garbage by the city, the said council may adopt such measures ^{city.} applicable to certain parts of the city only or to the whole city, on varying conditions, according to the various cases and as may be deemed to the advantage of the inhabitants of the city.

Contribution to Quebec Technical School.

9. Section 47 of the act 7 Edward VII, chapter 62 is replaced by the following :

“ 47. The city is authorized to contribute to an amount not exceeding \$10,000.00 annually to the maintenance of the Quebec Technical School.”

Powers of police officers &c.

10. Paragraph 1 of section 13 of the act 36 Victoria, chapter 55, is replaced by the following ;

“ 1. Police officers and constables shall have power to enter any house, building or other place in which spirituous liquors are sold or exposed for sale on the days and during the hours on and during which such trade in liquors is prohibited by law or by the by-laws of the city council.

Coming into force.

11. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 81

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Montreal

[Assented to 29th May, 1909]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the city of Montreal has, by its petition, represented that it is in the interest of the proper administration of its affairs that its charter, the act 62 Victoria, chapter 58, and the acts amending it, be amended, and whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

62 V., c. 58, s. 5, amended.

1. Article 5 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 58, as amended by the acts 7 Edward VII, chapter 63, section 1, and 8 Edward VII, chapter 85, section 1, is further amended by adding the following paragraphs, after paragraph *b* :

Mount Royal Ward.

“ *c.* The following shall be annexed to the city and form part of Mount Royal ward :

Boundaries of territory annexed to Mount Royal Ward.

1. A territory being No. 26 of the official plan and book of reference of the village of la Côte des Neiges, situate in the town of Outremont, and bounded as follows : on the southeast side by lot No. 10 of the cadastre of the village of la Côte des Neiges ; on the southwest side by lot No. 25 of the cadastre of the village of la Côte des Neiges ; on the northwest side by lot No. 27 of the cadastre of the village of la Côte des Neiges ; and on the northeast side by lot No. 11 of the cadastre of the village of
