

CHAP. 172

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Victor Darveau to the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics

[Assented to 27th April, 1909]

WHEREAS Victor Darveau, of St. Sauveur de Québec, Preamble.
has, by his petition, represented ;

That he has obtained from Laval University, in Quebec, the diploma of Doctor of Medicine, on the twenty-first of September, 1908, after having duly followed the regular courses of the said university during the period fixed by law ;

That he began to follow the courses of the said university before having obtained the certificate admitting him to the study of medicine ;

That since then he has obtained his certificate of admission to the study of medicine from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, after passing the necessary examination and was duly admitted to the study of medicine by the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, on the twenty-fourth of September, 1907 ;

That he is qualified to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics ,

That he cannot obtain his license to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics until he has completed his four years as a medical student ;

That such delay causes him great damage ;

That he has obtained the consent of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to the passing of an act to authorize the said College to grant him the necessary license to practise his profession ;

Whereas he has prayed that an act be passed to that effect and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Victor Darveau among its members and to grant him the necessary license to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this Province.

College of Physicians, &c., of P. Q., may admit V. Darveau.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
