

2. The Agent-General appointed in virtue of this act, shall be the official representative of this Province in the United Kingdom, and shall reside in said Kingdom. To represent Province in United Kingdom, &c.

He shall be under the control of the Prime Minister, and shall follow the instructions which may be given him, from time to time, by the latter. Under control of Prime Minister, &c

3. The Agent-General shall receive a salary of six thousand dollars a year. Salary.

4. The aggregate salary and the expenses which the Agent-General may incur in the performance of his duties, whether for the maintenance of his office or for any other proper purpose, shall not exceed eleven thousand dollars and shall be paid by warrant of the Lieutenant-Governor out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund of the Province. Limit of salary and office expenses, &c.

5. This act shall come into force on the day the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may be pleased to fix by proclamation. Coming into force.

CHAP. 12

An Act to amend the declaratory and interpretative provisions of the Revised Statutes

[Assented to 14th April, 1908]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 29 of the Revised Statutes is replaced by the following : R. S. Q., 29, replaced.

“ **29.** Unless the court or judge before whom a prosecution is to be brought, or the procedure which is to be followed, are mentioned in the statute enacting a penalty, the prosecution shall be brought, tried and decided before a magistrate, in accordance with the provisions of part XV of the Criminal Code.” Prosecutions, how brought, &c.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
