

CHAP. 21

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes respecting Stamps

[Assented to 14th April, 1908]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1161 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by the act R.S.Q., 1161, 52 Victoria, chapter 14, section 2, is repealed. ^{repealed.}

2. Article 1162, of the said statutes as amended by the act Id., 1162, 52 Victoria, chapter 14, section 2, is replaced by the following : ^{replaced.}

“ **1162.** It shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor in Appointment Council to appoint any person or persons, for the sale of stamps of stamp sellers, &c. in any locality, with such remuneration and under such conditions as he may determine.”

3. Article 1163 of the said statutes is replaced by the following : Id., s. 1163, ^{replaced.}

“ **1163.** The persons so appointed to sell stamps, shall be ^{Duties of} bound, at all times, to keep on hand such a supply of stamps, ^{such persons,} during the period of their appointment, as may be reasonably ^{&c.} expected to be required of them, and shall be bound to sell them to all persons who may demand the same, upon payment to them of the value of such stamps ; and in case of any violation of any duty imposed by this article, they shall forfeit, as ^{Penalty.} a penalty to His Majesty, a sum not exceeding twenty dollars, and shall further be liable for the damages sustained by any person through such violation of duty.”

4. Article 1164 of the said statutes, is amended by repeal- Id., 1164, ing all the words following the word “ thereof ”, in the ninth ^{amended.} line.

5. Article 1169 of the said statutes is amended by repealing Id., 1169, all the words following the word “ section ”, in the third line. ^{amended.}

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into force.}
