

CHAP. 78

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting the annulling of letters patent

[Assented to 14th April, 1908]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1008 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph : C. C. P., art. 1008, amended.

“They may also be made in the name and upon the suit of any other person interested.”

2. Article 1009 of the said Code is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph : Id., art. 1009 amended.

“When the writ is demanded by any person other than His Majesty’s Attorney-General or Solicitor-General, or some other officer duly authorized for such purpose, it cannot be issued, unless the *fiat* or *praecipe* is accompanied by a written authorization of the Attorney General.” Issue of writ in certain cases.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

CHAP. 79

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure and the Revised Statutes respecting the Commissioners’ Court

[Assented to 14th April, 1908]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Appendix of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by inserting the following schedules after schedule CC : Appendix C. C. P., amended.
