CHAP. I

An Act granting to His Majesty the moneys required for the expenses of the Government for the financial year ending on the 30th June, 1908, and for other purposes connected with the public service.

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

MOST GRACIOUS SOVEREIGN,

WHEREAS it appears, by messages from the Honourable ^{Preamble.} Sir Louis Amable Jetté, K. C. M. G., Lieutenant-Governor of this Province, and the estimates accompanying the same, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Government of the Province, not otherwise provided for, for the financial year ending on the 30th June, 1908, and for other purposes connected with the public service; May it, therefore, please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted, by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, that :

1. From and out of the consolidated revenue fund of this Province, a sum, not exceeding in the whole two millions, five hundred and forty nine thousand, nine hundred and forty four dollars and sixty-two cents, may be taken for defraying, during the financial year ending on the 30th June, 1908, the charges and expenses of the Government and public service of the Province, as set forth in the Schedule annexed to this act. ^{\$2,549,944.62} ^{may be taken for the year ending 30th June, 1908, for purposes mentioned in schedule.}

2. Every payment or application of moneys, appropriated by this act, shall be held to be made provisionally, and subject to all adjustment in account hereafter, in respect of the Dominion and of the Province of Ontario, and of special funds which this act may in any manner affect. ^{Payments subject to adjustment of accounts with Dominion, &c.}

3. Accounts, in detail, of all moneys expended under the authority of this act, shall be laid before both Houses of the Legislature of the Province, at the next session thereof.

4. The application of all sums expended under the authority of this act shall also be accounted for to His Majesty.
