

6 The remuneration of the commissioners and secretary, ^{Payment how made.} with such expenses as may be incurred by them for travelling, stationery, and other things necessary for the due performance of their duties under this act, shall be paid by warrants of the Lieutenant-Governor out of the consolidated Revenue Fund of the Province.

7. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc- ^{Coming into force.} tion.

CHAP. 6

An Act respecting the English originals of certain statutes

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of February last, the English ^{Preamble.} version of the bills which had not then been distributed, was destroyed by fire, and it is important to pass an act to rectify the situation thereby created.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. There shall be prepared forthwith, under the control of ^{Preparation of printed copy of statutes not sanctioned in English, &c.} the Clerk of the Legislature, a printed copy of the statutes, which, by reason of the said fire, could not be sanctioned in the English language, and the Lieutenant-Governor may endorse on each of such statutes a statement, signed by him, that the same has been sanctioned.

Such statutes shall be deposited among the records of the ^{Deposit thereof among records of Clerk.} Clerk of the Legislature, who shall keep the same, as being the English originals of the statutes, in accordance with the provisions of article 37 of the Revised Statutes.

2. The copy of the said statutes so deposited, shall be ^{Shall be English originals of said statutes.} deemed to be, for all legal purposes, the original of the statutes in English, contained therein.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into force.}
