An Act to amend the Education Act

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 148 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 28, as 62 V., c. 28, amended by the act 4 Edward VII, chapter 18, section 6, is art. 148, amended.
amended :

a. By inserting, after the word "proprietor" in the second line of the first paragraph, the words : "or husband of the proprietor" ;

b. By inserting, after the word "proprietor" in the third line of the said paragraph, the words : "or husband of the proprietor."

2. Article 291 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 28, is replaced *Id.*, art. 291, replaced.
by the following :

"291. The service of the special notice may be made *Service of special notice.*
between seven o'clock in the morning and seven o'clock in the afternoon, every day in the year, and even on non-juridical days.

But it cannot be made at a place of business except on *Proviso.*
juridical days and between nine o'clock in the morning and four o'clock in the afternoon.

by the following :

"507. In order that a widow of an officer of primary in- *Widow's right to pension.*
struction shall be entitled to a pension, the said officer must have paid, during at least six years before he shall have ceased teaching, the stoppages prescribed by article 505 of this act."
