An Act to amend the Education Act

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 148 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 28, as 62 V., c. 28, amended by the act 4 Edward VII, chapter 18, section 6, is ^{art. 148,} amended.

a. By inserting, after the word "proprietor" in the second line of the first paragraph, the words : "or husband of the proprietor" ;

b. By inserting, after the word "proprietor" in the third line of the said paragraph, the words : "or husband of the proprietor."

2. Article 291 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 28, is replaced ^{Id., art. 291,} by the following : ^{replaced.}

"**291.** The service of the special notice may be made ^{Service of} between seven o'clock in the morning and seven o'clock in ^{special} the afternoon, every day in the year, and even on non-juridical days. ^{notice.}

But it cannot be made at a place of business except on ^{Proviso.} juridical days and between nine o'clock in the morning and four o'clock in the afternoon.
