

7. The amount of the said annuity shall be chargeable upon the special funds created by the act 12 Victoria, chapter 112.

8. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council is authorized to sell the present gaol of the district of Montreal, and may appropriate the proceeds of the sale thereof to the fund for the redemption of the said debentures in principal and interest.

9. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 37

An Act to amend the Revised Statutes

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1343*d* of the Revised Statutes as enacted by the act 4 Edward VII, chapter 13, section 21, is amended by inserting, after the word : “ entitled ”, in the third line, the words : “ on applying therefor to the settler ”.

2. Article 1394*m* of the Revised Statutes as enacted by the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 18, section 11, is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph :

“ Nevertheless every person committing an offence, on a salmon river, shall be liable for the first offence to a fine of not less than fifty dollars, nor more than seventy-five dollars ; for the second offence, to a fine of not less than one hundred nor more than one hundred and twenty-five dollars ; and for the third to an imprisonment of not less than six months nor more than one year.”

3. Article 1394*aa* of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 18, section 13, is replaced by the following :

“ **1394aa.** Whosoever uses dynamite or other explosives for catching or killing fish to which this section applies, is liable to an imprisonment of not less than one year and not more than two years.”

4. The following articles are added after article 1395*g* of R. S. Q., art. the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the act 62 Victoria, ^{1395*g* added.} chapter 23, section 1.

“**1395*h*.** The Superintendent of Fisheries may kill or ^{Superintend-} caused to be killed sheldrake duck or king-fishers on salmon ^{ent may kill} rivers, at all times of the year” ^{certain birds.}

“**1395*i*.** It shall be lawful for the Minister of Coloniza- ^{Sanction of} tion, Mines and Fisheries to sanction any sale made by settlers ^{certain sales} of fishing rights, as regards lots granted to settlers by ^{by Minister,} location ^{&c.} ticket previous to the first day of June, 1884, when said lots border on non navigable rivers ; and such authority shall be vested in the Minister of Colonization, Mines and Fisheries, notwithstanding that the improvements required by law have not been made, and even if the location ticket of said lot granted before 1st June, 1884, has been cancelled ; provided, however, that the sale took place previous to said cancellation.

The above provisions shall apply to sales made by squat- ^{In what cases} ters who took possession of the lots previous to the first day ^{to apply.} of June, 1884, and who have been or may be recognized as being entitled to the land on which they squatted.”

5. Article 1405 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by the ^{R. S. Q.,} act 62 Victoria, chapter 24, section 1, and as amended by the ^{1405, am.} acts 1 Edward VII, chapter 12, section 5, and 2 Edward VII, chapter 14, section 3, and replaced by the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 19, section 10, is amended by striking out the words “from the fourth day”, in the fifth line thereof.

6. The following article is added after article 2340*c* of the ^{R. S. Q.,} Revised Statutes, as enacted by the act 61 Victoria, chapter ^{art. 2340*d*,} 19, section 6 : ^{added.}

“**2340*d*.** The Circuit Court in and for the district of ^{Concurrent} Ottawa at St. Ignace de Nominingue, has concurrent jurisdic- ^{jurisdiction} tion over the townships of Nantel, Lynch and Mousseau, in ^{of C.
