An Act to amend the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 37, respecting
the liberal professions

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following article is added to the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 37, after article 1 thereof : Article added after 3 Ed. VII, c. 37,

"2. This act shall apply to the professions of advocate, of notary, of physician, of dentist, of surveyor, of architect, of civil engineer, of chemist, and of veterinary surgeon." of art. 1. Act to apply to advocates, &c.

An Act to amend the Cities and Towns' Act, 1903

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The English version of article 355 of the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 38, is amended by replacing the word : " eight " in the second line by the word : " fifteen ". 3 Ed. VII, c. 38, art. 355, amended.

2. Article 357 of the said act, is amended by replacing the words " half an hour " in the first line by the words : " an hour ". Id., art. 357, amended.

3. Article 512 of the said act is amended by replacing the words : " by the clerk " in the second line by the words : " by the mayor or by the clerk ". Id., art. 512, amended.

4. The following article is inserted in the said act after article 531 : Id., art. 531a, added.

" 531a. Notwithstanding the provisions of this section the Temporary council may, pending the collection of the general and special taxes and of the water-rate, on mere resolution and without being bound to obtain the approval of the electors who
