An Act respecting life insurance for the benefit of educational institutions

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

R. S. Q. 5606 s. and art. added. **1.** The following section and article are inserted in the Revised Statutes after article 5606 :

“SECTION *INæ*

LIFE INSURANCE FOR THE BENEFIT OF EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

Life insurance for benefit of superior educational institutions.

Conditions, &c.

“**5606a.** Every person capable of contracting, may insure his life for the benefit of an institution of superior education incorporated and capable of receiving by gift *inter vivos*. The premiums may be payable by another person. Notwithstanding article 776 of the Civil Code, such contract and its acceptance may be made by private writing, but it shall remain subject to the provisions of article 762 of the same code. The contract cannot be revoked without the consent of the beneficiary.”

C H A P. 53

An Act to further amend the act respecting tolls on the South Shore Turnpike Roads

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Schedule, 18 V., c. 160, s. 3, amended.

Motor vehicles to pay 30 cts etc.

1. The schedule to section 3 of the act 18 Victoria, chapter 160, as replaced by the act 56 Victoria, chapter 48, section 1, is amended by adding thereto the following :

“For every vehicle, being a motor vehicle within the meaning of the act 6 Edward VII, chapter 13, the sum of thirty cents payable one-half going and one-half returning.”

2. Section 3 of the act 23 Victoria, chapter 69 is amended 23 V., c. 69, s 3, amended.
by adding thereto the following paragraph :

“Nevertheless the trustees of the South Shore Turnpike Trustees of South Shore Turnpike Roads, may commute tolls, &c.
Roads may commute tolls at toll gates and bridges in accordance with the regulations they may pass from time to time.”

CHAP. 54

An Act to amend article 981^o of the Civil Code

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 981^o of the Civil Code, as contained in article Article 981^o
5803 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by inserting after C. C. amend-
ed.
the word “debentures” in the fifteenth line, the words “or
in the bonds or debentures of any school corporation in any city or town of this Province.”

CHAP. 55

An Act to amend article 2359 of the Civil Code, respecting the responsibility of architects and builders

[Assented to 14th March, 1907]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 2259 of the Civil Code is replaced by the following : Art. 2259 C. C. replaced.

“**2259.** The action for indemnity under article 1688 Prescription of actions under article 1688 C. C.
must be taken within ten years from the date of the loss.
If, however, the defect is one which is only gradually revealed, prescription shall begin to run from the expiration of Proviso.
the ten years mentioned in article 1688.”
