

## C H A P. 160

An Act to authorize the Province of Quebec Association of Architects to admit Arthur Content amongst its members

[Assented to 28th February, 1907]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS Arthur Content, of the city of Montreal, has, by his petition, represented :

That he has regularly attended an architect's office for four years previous to the 15th January, 1899, and since then, without interruption, in the Province of Quebec ;

That, under the provisions of section 7 of the act 54 Victoria, chapter 59, as amended by the act 61 Victoria, chapter 33, section 2, he was authorized to become a member of the said Association on payment of the required fees to the secretary thereof, within a delay of six months from the publication of the notice of the organization of the council of the said Association ;

That such notice was published in the *Quebec Official Gazette* during the month of March, 1898, but that the petitioner became cognisant thereof only a long while after the expiration of the said six months' delay ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act to allow him to become a member of the said Architects' Association by having his name registered by the secretary thereof and authorizing the Association to admit him among its members on payment by him of the regular fee and all arrears ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Arthur Content is authorized to become a member of the Province of Quebec Association of Architects, by having his name registered by the secretary thereof, and on payment by him of the fees and arrears necessary for such purpose ; and the said Association is authorized to admit the said Arthur Content upon the fulfilment of the aforesaid conditions ; provided, however, that the said Arthur Content proves that he has regularly attended an architect's office for the four years preceding the 15th of January, 1898.
