CHAP. 9

An Act to detach certain lots from the township of Tingwick, in the county of Arthabaska, and to annex them to Kingsey Falls, in the county of Drummond, for all purposes

[Assented to 11th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Certain lots detached from Arthabaska and annexed to Drummond.

1. Lots numbers twenty-six, twenty-seven, twenty-eight and twenty-nine in the first range of the township of Tingwick, are hereby detached from the said township of Tingwick and county of Arthabaska and annexed to Kingsey Falls and to the county of Drummond, for all purposes except for registration purposes.

R.S., 64, Nos. 2 and 18 of table, modified.

2. The limits of the counties of Arthabaska and Drummond, fixed respectively by numbers 2 and 18 of the table to article 64 of the Revised Statutes, are modified accordingly.

Coming into force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
