" 1593f. Prosecutions for an infringement of this act and for the recovery of the penalty shall be brought by and in the name of the collector of provincial revenue of the district in which the offence was committed, before two justices of the peace, the district magistrate or the Circuit Court of the district or county in which the offence was committed.

" 1593g. Such inspectors shall also have all the powers granted to inspectors under the provisions of the act 1 Edward VII, chapter 19, section 48.

" 1593h. It shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor in council to make all such regulations as may be necessary to enforce the due carrying out of this act, which regulations shall be published once in the *Quebec Official Gazette* and shall thereafter have all the force of law."

CHAP. 18

An Act to amend the law respecting Farmers' Clubs

[Assented to 11th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 1675*w* of the Revised Statutes, as replaced by the act 61 Victoria, chapter 17, section 3, is again replaced by the following :

General meet-
ing to be held
yearly.

" 1675*w*. The directors shall each year convene a general meeting of the members of the club, at which lectures on agriculture shall be given.

Public admit-
ted to lectures.
Grant taken
away if meet-
ing not held.
Report to
Minister.

The public shall be admitted to such lectures.

In default of such meeting being held the provincial grant may be refused.

During the fifteen days following every such meeting the president and secretary shall sign and transmit to the Minister of Agriculture a report setting forth the date of the

meeting, the name of the lecturer or lecturers, the subject dealt with, and the approximate number of persons present."

CHAP. 19

An Act to amend the Education act

[Assented to 11th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 13 of the act 62 Victoria, chapter 28, is amended 62 V., c. 28, s.
13, amended. by adding thereto the following clauses :

" Whenever in the school law and regulations there are Interpreta-
tion. mentioned, the words : " elementary school," they shall designate any primary elementary school ; the words : " model school," any primary intermediate school, and the words : " academy school " or " academy " any primary superior school.

The courses which correspond to these various grades of schools are called " elementary courses, " intermediate courses " and " superior courses."

2. Article 308 of the said act is amended by adding after Id., 308,
amended. the words " justice of the peace," in the sixth line, the words, " or the mayor of the municipality."
