

## C H A P. 25

An Act to amend the law respecting the Province of Quebec  
Association of Architects

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows :

54 V., c. 59,  
s. 13, amend-  
ed.

**1.** The second clause of section 13 of the act 54 Vic-  
toria, chapter 59, as replaced by the act 61 Victoria, chapter  
33, section 4, is again replaced by the following :

Penalty for  
using name  
of architect  
without  
being mem-  
ber of asso-  
ciation.

“ Any person who, after the time above mentioned,  
although not being registered as a member of the said  
association, takes or makes use of any such name, title or  
designation as above mentioned, shall be liable to a fine  
not exceeding twenty-five dollars for the first offence, and  
not exceeding one hundred dollars for every subsequent  
offence, and in default of immediate payment of the fine  
and costs, imprisonment for a period not exceeding ninety  
days, unless such penalty and costs be sooner paid.”

**2.** The following sections are added after section 13 of the  
said act :

Prosecutions  
before what  
court  
brought, &c.

“ **13a.** Prosecutions instituted for the recovery of any fine  
imposed under this act may be instituted by the association  
or by any person, before the district magistrate's court, the  
Circuit Court or the Superior Court having jurisdiction  
according to the amount claimed.

Application  
of fees, penal-  
ties and fines.

“ **13b.** All fees, penalties and fines payable under section 13  
of this act shall belong to the Association of Architects of the  
Province of Quebec to form part of its general fund.”

Coming into  
force.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanc-  
tion.
