

CHAP. 33

An Act to amend article 176 of the Municipal Code

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 176 of the Municipal Code, as replaced by the M. C., 176, act 55-56 Victoria, chapter 44, section 1, is amended by adding thereto the following clause :

“If, in any municipality, fifteen resident electors are not satisfied with the auditing by the corporation auditor of the accounts of its secretary-treasurer, the council shall, upon their petition, appoint the auditor selected by them. Such auditor shall have the right to audit the accounts of the secretary-treasurer for the five years immediately preceding, and, if such accounts are found correct, the cost of such auditing shall be paid by them, but, if otherwise, it shall be paid by the municipality. And, if the council refuses or neglects to make the appointment asked for, at its first general session following the filing of the petition, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may appoint such auditor.”

CHAP. 34

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting the sessions of county councils

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 256 of the Municipal Code is replaced by the following :

M. C., 256, replaced.

“**256.** The ordinary or general sessions of county councils are held on the second Wednesday in each of the months of March, June, September and December ; but any county council may, by by-law, ordain that the ordinary or general sessions thereof shall be held only on the second Wednesday in each of the months of March and September.”
