An Act to amend articles 337, 545, 546 and 760 of the
Municipal Code

[*Assented to 20th May, 1905*]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows :

M. C., 337,
amended.

1. Article 337 of the Municipal Code, as it is contained in article 6083 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by adding after the word : "neighboring," in the fourth line of paragraph 3, the word : "rural."

amended.

2. Article 545 of the said Code is amended by adding thereto the following words : "as well as crossings, to communicate from one side of the street or road to the other."

amended.

3. Article 546 of the said Code, as it is contained in article 6116 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by adding thereto the word : "crossings" after the word : "side-walks," in the first and second lines.

4. Article 760 of the said Code, as amended by the act 2 Edward VII, chapter 46, section 1, is further amended by adding after the words : "two preceding articles," in the second line, the words : "whether before the act 2 Edward VII, chapter 46, or not."

An Act to amend the Municipal Code, respecting the erection of certain buildings

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Leg-

1. The following article is inserted in the Municipal Code before article 464 :

"**463a.** It shall be lawful for the council of any local municipality to enact, by by-law, that no dwelling house or

building of any kind shall be erected or maintained in, over or upon the ground, within a distance of two feet from the boundary line between this Province and the United States of North America.”

CH A P. 3 7

An Act to amend the provisions of the Municipal Code, respecting the width of wheel tires

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The following article is inserted in the Municipal Code after article 548*a*, as enacted by the act 53 Victoria, chapter 63, section 5 :

Art. added after M. C., 548*a*.

“**548*b*.** The powers granted to county councils by article 520*a* are extended to councils of rural municipalities, as regards all vehicles owned or habitually used within the municipality.”

CH A P. 3 8

An Act to amend article 562 of the Municipal Code

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 562 of the Municipal Code, as it is contained in article 6120 of the Revised Statutes, is amended by replacing all the words after the word : “promulgation,” in the fifth line, by the words : “provided that it has been promulgated on or before the thirty-first day of January, and if after that date, only on the first day of May of the year next thereafter, and provided also that, before the first of May after its promulgation, an authentic copy thereof has been sent to the collector of provincial revenue of the district.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
