

"40. No tenant or occupant shall exercise his rights as a municipal elector, if at the time he is called upon to exercise such rights, he has not so resided for six months within the limits of the municipality." Residence required to qualify to vote.

3. The provisions of the Municipal Code or any other law, inconsistent with the present act, shall not apply to the corporation of the village of *Pointe au Pic*. Inconsistent provisions of Municipal Code, &c., not to apply.

4. The corporation of the village of *Pointe au Pic* shall be obliged to reimburse to the municipality of the parish of *Saint-Etienne de la Malbaie* the sum of two hundred and twenty-eight dollars by it expended for the laying out by it of the road which is to cross the lands annexed by this act. Certain sum to be reimbursed to parish of St. Etienne.

5. The bridge mentioned in the act 40 Victoria, chapter 46, section 4, shall be under the control of the county council, and the works of maintenance and repair in future shall be at the cost of the municipalities of the parish of *Saint Etienne de la Malbaie*, of the village of *Malbaie* and of the village of *Pointe au Pic*, and be divided between the three municipalities according to the valuation of their taxable property. Control of certain bridge. Maintenance and repair thereof.

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

C H A P . 5 2

An Act to further amend the charter of the Atlantic,
Quebec and Western Railway Company

[Assented to 11th May, 1905]

WHEREAS the Atlantic, Quebec and Western Railway Company has, by petition, prayed that its charter be amended as hereinafter set forth, by adding certain provisions for the purpose of simplifying the deeds of conveyance of land to the company for the purposes of its undertaking, and to determine the method and cost of registration thereof; and whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition; Preamble.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. All deeds of conveyance of land to the company, for the purposes of its undertaking, shall, as far as possible, be Form of deeds of conveyance of lands.

in accordance with Schedule A of this act, or according to any other form of like tenor.

Books to be supplied to registrars.

For the purpose of registration of such conveyances, the company may, at its own cost, supply the registrar of any county with a book containing printed blank forms of such Schedule A, or of any other of like tenor, for the registration of such conveyances by transcription according to the requirements of the law.

Fees on registration.

The registrars shall have the right to charge fifty cents for all costs of such registration.

Effect of registration.

The said registration shall be valid notwithstanding any law to the contrary, and shall have the same effect as that prescribed by the Civil Code.

2. Article 26 of the act 1 Edward VII, chapter 63, as replaced by the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 85, section 1, is again replaced by the following :

Commencement and completion of works.

“**26.** The works authorized by this act shall be commenced in good faith within the delay of two years and the said railway shall be completed within a delay of five years from the sanction of this act.”

Coming into force.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
