

## CHAP. 64

## An Act to amend the charter of the Canadian Light and Power Company.

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

**W**HEREAS the Canadian Light and Power Company has, Preamble.  
by its petition, prayed that its charter be amended,  
and it is expedient to grant such prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of  
Quebec, enacts as follows :
