

CHAP. 98

An Act to exempt part of the property of *L'Hôpital Guay de St. Joseph de Lévis* from all taxes and legal assessments

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

WHEREAS the corporation of *L'Hôpital Guay de St. Joseph de Lévis*, incorporated by the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 118, has, by petition, represented that it desires, in its own interest, that a portion of its property be exempt from all taxes, because such hospital was established for purposes of public charity, to receive the aged poor and homeless of both sexes; Preamble.

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed to that effect and it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. *L'Hôpital Guay de St. Joseph de Lévis*, its dependencies, property and grounds, known on the official cadastre of the parish of St. Joseph de Lévis as numbers 15 and 16 of Lauzon village, shall be exempt from all municipal, school, and *fabrique* taxes and from all other assessment affecting the property of private individuals, because such hospital is established for purposes of public charity. Hospital and dependencies to be exempt from taxes.

2. In the event of any part of the said lots 15 and 16 being sold as building lots, such building lots shall cease to be exempt from taxes. If any part of lots 15 and 16 sold, taxes to be then payable.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
