

## CHAP. 115

An Act to authorize George Andrew Clunie to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

Preamble.

**W**HEREAS George Andrew Clunie, of the town of Lachute, in the district of Terrebonne, has, by his petition, represented :

That, in the year 1883, he received from McGill University the degree of associate of arts ;

That he also holds the degree of doctor of dental surgery from the Chicago College of Dental Surgery, entitling him to practise as a dental surgeon in the State of Illinois, one of the United States of America ;

That, for family reasons, it became desirable for him to return to this province, which he has done, and is now settled in the town of Lachute ;

That he is desirous of practising his profession in this province ;

That his petition has been approved by the board of Governors of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas he has prayed that an act be passed to authorize him to form part of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to grant to George Andrew Clunie a license of surgeon-dentist in this province, with all the privileges connected therewith, after examination for admission to study and to practise, before the said College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec.
