An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Alfred Hunter Oliver amongst its members after examination

[Assented to 20th May, 1905]

WHEREAS Alfred Hunter Oliver, of Mansonville, in the Preamble. township of Potton, district of Bedford, dentist, has by petition, represented :

That he was born at Mansonville aforesaid, and is a British subject ;

That he intended taking up his residence in the State of Vermont, and with that end in view attended the State University of Maryland at Baltimore, in the United States of America, from which he graduated on the second day of May, 1904, as a dentist, taking the degree of D.D.S. (Doctor of Dental Surgery) ;

That since his graduation, upon the earnest solicitation of members of his family, he has decided to take up his residence in the Province of Quebec, at Sutton, Brome County ;

That he has practised dentistry since his graduation with A. A. Graham, L. D. S., of the village of Granby, in the district of Bedford, as his assistant ;

That the petitioner is well qualified, both in theoretical and practical knowledge, to take up the practice of dentistry ;

That he is willing to pass the examinations required by the law of the Province of Quebec, but is anxious that he should be relieved from the course of studentship required by said law ;

That the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, on the 1st day of February, 1905, resolved and decided to approve an act to be passed by this Legislature to admit the said Alfred Hunter Oliver to the practice of dentistry in said province after examination ;

Whereas the petitioner has, by his petition, prayed that an act to that effect be passed, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Admission of
A. H. Oliver
as a dentist
authorized.

1. The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Alfred Hunter Oliver to present himself for examination for admission to the study and practice of dentistry at any time hereafter, and, after such examination, to admit him amongst the members of the College of Dental Surgeons of this Province.
