

## CHAP. 7

An Act to detach certain lots from the parish of Sainte Eulalie, in the county of Arthabaska, and to annex them to the parish of Saint Samuel in the county of Nicolet for all purposes

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

**W**HEREAS the competent ecclesiastical authorities have Preamble.  
detached certain lots from the parish of Sainte Eulalie, in the augmentation of the township of Bulstrode, in the county of Athabaska, and annexed them to the parish of Saint Samuel, in the county of Nicolet, for religious purposes, and it would consequently be now advantageous for the inhabitants thereof if the said lots were also annexed to the said parish for all other purposes;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Lots numbers four, five and six in the ninth range of the augmentation of the township of Bulstrode, being designated, in the official cadastre and book of reference of the parish of Sainte Eulalie, as numbers one hundred and forty-four, one hundred and forty-five and one hundred and forty-six, containing one hundred and twenty acres, are hereby detached from the said parish of Sainte Eulalie and county of Arthabaska and annexed to the parish of Saint Samuel and to the county of Nicolet for all purposes. Lots detached from Ste. Eulalie and annexed to St. Samuel.

**2.** The limits of the counties of Arthabaska and Nicolet, fixed respectively by numbers 2 and 42 of the table to article 64 of the Revised Statutes, are modified accordingly. R. S., 64, amended.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
