An Act to amend the law respecting pawnbrokers

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 272 of the act 63 Victoria, chapter 12, is replaced by the following :

“**272.** The pawnbroker may sell all articles pawned but not redeemed within one year from but exclusive of the day of pawning, without the formality of a judgment to that effect, notwithstanding article 1971 of the Civil Code.

When, however, the sum lent on any such article exceeds two dollars, the sale must be at public auction and not otherwise.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

C H A P. 12

An Act respecting marriage licenses

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Articles 1206 and 1207 of the Revised Statutes are replaced by the following :

“**1206.** In so far as regards the solemnization of marriage by ministers of any religious denomination other than the Roman Catholic religion, all marriage licenses shall be issued from the department of the Provincial Treasurer, under the hand and seal of the Lieutenant-Governor who, for the purposes of such licenses, is the competent authority under article 59 of the Civil Code.

Every license issued shall be and remain valid notwithstanding that, at the date at which it is furnished to the persons requiring the same, the office and functions of the Lieutenant-Governor who has signed it, are executed by an administrator.
