## An Act to amend the Civil Code

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** The following article is added to the Civil Code after article 290 : Art. added after C. C., 290.

“ **290a.** The tutor may, with the authorization of the judge, upon the advice of the family council, in the case of an established business, continue the same. Tutor may continue business.”

Such power may be revoked at any time by order of the court, judge or prothonotary upon the advice of the family council.” Revocation of power.

## C H A P . 42

An act to amend article 1301 of the Civil Code respecting the capacity of married women to make certain contracts

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

**W**HEREAS doubts have arisen as to the meaning of article 1301 of the Civil Code ; Preamble.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

**1.** Article 1301 of the Civil Code never applied to purchases, sales, or exchanges of immoveable property or to emphyteutic leases made by married women. Declarations as to application of C. C., 1301.

**2.** Article 1301 of the said Code is amended by adding thereto the following words : “ saving the rights of creditors who contract in good faith.” C. C., 1301, amended.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction, but shall not affect cases then pending. Coming into force and pending cases.
