

C H A P . 45

An Act to amend articles 8 and 86 of the Code of Civil Procedure, respecting the transaction of legal business on Saturday

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 8 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto the following clause : C. C. P., 8, amended.

“ If the day on which any proceeding should be served or produced is a Saturday, the proceeding may be served or produced with a like effect on the following juridical day.” Proceedings, &c., need not to be made on Saturday.

2. Article 86 of the said Code is amended by adding thereto the following clause : C. C. P., 86, amended.

“ No service upon an attorney of a party can be made after one o'clock on Saturday afternoon, either at his office or at the prothonotary's office.” Service upon attorneys on Saturdays.

C H A P . 46

An Act to authorize the mayors of municipalities to administer oaths

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 29 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto the following clause : C. C. P., 29, amended.

“The mayor of every municipality in the province is authorized to administer the same oath as a commissioner of the Superior Court.” Mayors may administer certain oaths.
