

CHAP. 45

An Act to amend articles 8 and 86 of the Code of Civil Procedure, respecting the transaction of legal business on Saturday

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 8 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto the following clause : C. C. P., 8, amended.

" If the day on which any proceeding should be served or produced is a Saturday, the proceeding may be served or produced with a like effect on the following juridical day." Proceedings, &c., need not to be made on Saturday.

2. Article 86 of the said Code is amended by adding thereto the following clause : C. C. P., 86, amended.

" No service upon an attorney of a party can be made after one o'clock on Saturday afternoon, either at his office or at the prothonotary's office." Service upon attorneys on Saturdays.

CHAP. 46

An Act to authorize the mayors of municipalities to administer oaths

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. Article 29 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding thereto the following clause : C. C. P., 29, amended.

"The mayor of every municipality in the province is authorized to administer the same oath as a commissioner of the Superior Court." Mayors may administer certain oaths.
