An act to amend the charter of the city of Sorel

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

WHEREAS the city of Sorel has, by its petition, prayed Preamble.
for certain amendments to its charter and to the various
provisions amending the same, and whereas it is expedient to
grant its prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The paragraph added to article 433 of the act 52 Vic- 52 V., c. 80,
toria, chapter 80, by the act 62 Victoria, chapter 60, section art. 433,
amended.
7, is replaced by the following :

“ Favor any person, association or company, under such Aid, &c., to
building, &c.,
of slaughter-

guarantees as may be proper to exact for building, operating
and maintaining a public slaughter-house with all proper
restrictions as to the tariff of charges which shall be exigible ;
grant to any such enterprise a special temporary privilege
as to the slaughtering of cattle, the fresh meat whereof may
be sold or offered for sale within the city limits, with such
advantages or exemptions from taxes as may be lawful and
established by by-law ; such by-law shall limit the duration
of the privilege, set forth, the conditions attached to its main-
tenance, and declare that the enjoyment of the privilege shall
cease before the appointed time owing to the non-accomplish-
ment of the said conditions or obligations.

This provision shall not apply to farmers selling or offering Application

for sale the meat of any animals raised and killed by them.”

2. Paragraph 1 of section 348 of the act 52 Victoria chap- 52 V., c. 80,
ter 80, is replaced by the following : art. 348,
amended.

“ **348.** 1. Whenever one-third at least of the proprietors Common
sewers, &c.
of real estate in a street or part of a street in the city shall, by
petition addressed to the city council, require the making of
a common sewer, the macadamizing or planking of, or
making any other improvements whatsoever to such street or
part of a street, the council may order such improvements to
be made and may regulate the manner of levying and collect-
ing a sufficient assessment to defray the cost thereof on the
persons who may be interested in such improvement or on
all proprietors of lands opposite to which such improvements
may be made”.
