An Act to amend the charter of the town of Fraserville

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

Preamble.

WHEREAS the corporation of the town of Fraserville has, by petition, represented that it has begun the construction and operation of a system of water-works and drainage; that such water-works and drainage are very expensive; that it has already spent for that object the amount it is authorized to borrow under its charter; that, in order to benefit by the expenditure hitherto incurred and to complete the said system of water-works and drainage, it would require an amount of \$150,000.00, and that it is in the interest of the said corporation that special powers to borrow be again granted it for the purposes aforesaid;

Whereas it has prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 186 of the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 69, is replaced by the following:

Power to borrow for certain purposes.

" 186. For the execution of the works mentioned in sections 175 to 184, inclusively, it shall be lawful for the town to issue debentures to an amount not exceeding \$300,000.00, by complying with the provisions of sections 198 and following.

Certain sum included.

In such sum is included the sum of one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, which the town was authorized to borrow by section 186 of the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 69."

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
