

CHAP. 117

An Act to repeal the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 135, respecting a sale by the estate of L. T. Macpherson to N. G. Kirouac and W. C. Kirouac

[Assented to 2nd June, 1904]

WHEREAS Napoléon Georges Kirouac and Wilbrod Cyrille Kirouac, both of the city of Quebec, merchants, have, by their petition, represented :

That the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 135, has become useless, inasmuch as the petitioners no longer wish to acquire, and the heirs of L. T. Macpherson no longer wish to sell, the immoveable mentioned in the preamble to the said act ;

Whereas the petitioners have prayed for an act to regularize their position, and it is expedient to grant their prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The act 3 Edward VII, chapter 135, is repealed to all intents and purposes, and Napoléon Georges Kirouac and Wilbrod Cyrille Kirouac, merchants, of Quebec, are authorized to retrocede to the heirs of Laughlan Thomas Macpherson, in his lifetime of the parish of St. Roch de Quebec, notary, the immoveable to them sold by deed of sale before W. Noble Campbell, notary, on the 14th January, 1903, being No. 5179 of the minutes of the said notary.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
