

CHAP. 52

An Act to amend the Code of Civil Procedure respecting
the District Magistrate's Court

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. C. P., 61,
amended.

1. Article 61 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended by adding, after the word : "Pontiac," in the third line of paragraph 1, the words : " in the county of Ottawa."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 53

An Act to amend article 314 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

C. C. P., 314,
§ 4, replaced.

1. Paragraph 4 of article 314 of the Code of Civil Procedure is replaced by the following :

wife when
admitted, &c.

" 4. Husband or wife against each other. Nevertheless, if consorts are separate as to property and one of them as agent has administered property belonging to the other, the consort who has so administered may be examined as a witness against the other in relation to any fact connected with such administration ; provided the court is of opinion, in view of the circumstances of the case, that it is just and advisable to order such examination. The default of a party to examine his consort in his favor, cannot be invoked against him."
