

C H A P. 74

An Act granting special power to the corporation of the village of Vaudreuil to borrow money for repairs and improvements to its system of water-works

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

WHEREAS the corporation of the village of Vaudreuil Preamble.
has, by petition, represented that it owes, for the water-works' system constructed by it jointly with the corporation of Dorion village, a sum of about sixteen thousand, five hundred dollars, and that, in order to derive benefit from the expenditure already made and to put the water-works' system in good order, it would have to spend about ten thousand dollars; that articles 495, 496, 498 and 978 of the Municipal Code, which apply to the said corporation, do not allow it to effect a loan under favorable conditions for the purposes of the said water-works, and that it is in the interest of the said corporation that special borrowing powers be granted to it for the above purposes;

And whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer contained in the said petition;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Articles 495, 496 and 498 as well as article 978 of the Municipal Code shall not apply to the debts and loans contracted and to be contracted for the improvement, maintenance and repairing of the present water-works' system of the said corporation. Certain articles of Municipal Code not to apply to certain debts and loans.

2. Articles 4523 to 4537, inclusively, of the Revised Statutes shall apply to the debts and loans contracted by the said corporation for the purposes of the said water-works. R. S., 4523 to 4537, to apply thereto.

3. At the meeting of electors, mentioned in article 4532 of the Revised Statutes, if half an hour elapses after the opening of the meeting without a poll being asked for, the by-law shall be deemed to have been unanimously adopted by the rate-payers interested. If poll not applied for within certain time at meeting, by-law to be approved.

4. The said corporation may, moreover, contract loans for the above purposes, by means of annuities payable yearly or half yearly, not to extend beyond a period of sixty years. Loans by annuities authorized.

5. The said corporation may consolidate the existing debt in connection with the said water-works and effect all loans or issues of bonds above provided for and necessary for such object.

Coming into

6. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.

CHAP. 75

An Act to erect a new village municipality in the municipality of the village of Notre Dame de Grâce West

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

Preamble.

WHEREAS P. Lemieux, Stanislas Viau, F. Xavier Décarie, Jérémie Prud'homme, J. H. McDonald and several other freehold inhabitants of the municipality of Notre Dame de Grâce West, in the *banlieue* of Montreal, in the county of Hochelaga, have prayed that, for their greater advantage, an act be passed to erect a new village municipality, comprising the lands of Côte St. Luc; and it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Name of
municipality.

1. The municipality hereinafter described shall be called "Municipality of the Village of Côte St. Luc."

boundaries of
municipality.

2. The municipality of the Village of Côte St. Luc shall be bounded as follows:

On the north-west by the parish of St. Laurent; on the south-west by the parish of Lachine; on the south and the south-west by the municipality of St. Pierre aux Liens and the municipality of Montreal West; on the south by the limits of the lots bearing the official numbers 143, 148, 152A, 154, 164, 71 and 70 of the cadastre for the parish of Montreal, all inclusively, and the Côte St. Luc road; on the north-east by number 67 exclusively, as far as the second street, thence by Monklands Avenue; on the north by the boundary of the municipality of Côte des Neiges, including number 45.

Municipal
Code to ap-
ply.

3. All the provisions of the Municipal Code shall apply to the municipality of the village of Côte St. Luc, in so far as they are not inconsistent with this act.
