CHAP. 75

An Act to erect a new village municipality in the municipality of the village of Notre Dame de Grâce West

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

Preamble.

WHEREAS P. Lemieux, Stanislas Viau, F. Xavier Décarie, Jérémie Prud'homme, J. H. McDonald and several other freehold inhabitants of the municipality of Notre Dame de Grâce West, in the *banlieue* of Montreal, in the county of Hochelaga, have prayed that, for their greater advantage, an act be passed to erect a new village municipality, comprising the lands of Côte St. Luc; and it is expedient to grant their prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Name of

1. The municipality hereinafter described shall be called "Municipality of the Village of Côte St. Luc."

boundaries of
municipality.

2. The municipality of the Village of Côte St. Luc shall be bounded as follows:

On the north-west by the parish of St. Laurent; on the south-west by the parish of Lachine; on the south and the south-west by the municipality of St. Pierre aux Liens and the municipality of Montreal West; on the south by the limits of the lots bearing the official numbers 143, 148, 152A, 154, 164, 71 and 70 of the cadastre for the parish of Montreal, all inclusively, and the Côte St. Luc road; on the north-east by number 67 exclusively, as far as the second street, thence by Monklands Avenue; on the north by the boundary of the municipality of Côte des Neiges, including number 45.

3. All the provisions of the Municipal Code shall apply to the municipality of the village of Côte St. Luc, in so far as they are not inconsistent with this act.

4. The first municipal election of the municipality shall be held one month after the sanction of this act under the presiding officer who shall be appointed for such purpose by the Lieutenant-Governor in council ; and all the articles of the Municipal Code, respecting elections and meetings of municipal electors shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to the first election of councillors.

5. The electors who shall have a right to vote at the first election shall be those qualified in the above-mentioned territory, and entered upon the valuation roll of the municipality of the village of Côte St. Luc.

6. The cost of this act shall be paid by the municipality of the village of Côte St. Luc.

CHAP. 76

An Act respecting the village of Boulevard St. Paul

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

WHEREAS the village of Boulevard St. Paul has, by its petition, represented that the provisions of the Municipal Code do not meet the requirements of its inhabitants, and has prayed for more extended powers ;

Preamble.

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. In addition to the powers conferred upon it by the Municipal Code, the municipal council of the village of Boulevard St. Paul may make, repeal or amend by-laws allowing it to grant to any persons or companies, for any number of years not exceeding thirty, an exclusive privilege for the operation of a tramway propelled by steam or electricity, on such conditions and in such manner as it may deem advisable.

2. Every by-law passed under this act, before coming into force and effect, must be approved by the majority of the proprietors of the municipality in number and in real value who shall vote upon such by-law, and by the Lieutenant-Governor in council.
