An Act to amend the act 20 Victoria, chapter 125, intituled: "An Act to divide the Quebec Turnpike Roads into separate trusts, and to make other provisions relative thereto," and the various acts amending the same

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

In event of refusal of Trust to commute certain tolls, Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint two additional members.

1. If, at any time, the Quebec South Shore Turnpike Road Trust refuses to commute the tolls with persons who make use of the said roads, as it was the custom previous to the year 1902, it shall be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, if he deems it advisable, to appoint immediately two persons who are residents on the south shore and within the limits of the county of Levis, as members of the said trust, in addition to the three members appointed by him under the provisions of the act 57 Victoria, chapter 54, section 1, and thereafter the said board shall consist of nine members, five appointed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council and four by the bondholders as provided in the said act.

Powers of additional members.

2. The additional members, appointed in virtue of section 1 of this act, shall be fully vested with all the powers and submitted to all the obligations of the other trustees now in office.

Coming into force.

3. This act shall come into force on the first day of July next.
