

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant such prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Admission

1. The Bar of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Joseph Adélarde Provencher amongst its members, after final examination and after he has paid the students' and practitioners' fees.

CHAP. 140

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to admit Marie Joseph Norbert René Faribault to the practice of the notarial profession, after examination

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Marie Joseph Norbert René Faribault, notarial student of the city of Montreal, in the district of Montreal, has, by petition, represented :

That he has followed a complete course of study at L'Assomption College, and obtained the degree of Bachelor of Arts from Laval University ;

That, on the seventh day of July, 1900, he was admitted to the study of law by the Montreal Bar ;

That, from the twelfth of July, 1900, to the ninth of June, 1902, he studied law as a student in the office of Louis Conrad Peltier, esquire, King's Counsel, of the law firm of Peltier and Letourneau, advocates, of Montreal, under indentures, dated the said twelfth of July, 1900 ;

That, since his admission to the study of law, he has been in regular attendance upon the law course of Laval University, in Montreal, during the university terms of 1900-1901 and 1901-1902, and also since the beginning of the year 1902-1903 ;

That the said Marie Joseph Norbert René Faribault has contracted a disease of the throat, chronic laryngitis, which makes it impossible for him to practise as an advocate ;

That, on the eighth day of July, 1902, he was admitted by the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec, to the study of the notarial profession ;

That since that time he has been in regular attendance as a notarial student in the office of a practising notary, and that he is under indenture as a student in the office of Cléophas Edouard Leclerc, notary, of Montreal ;

That, without a special act, he would be obliged to continue his clerkship, as such notarial student, during three consecutive years, and he would thereby experience a useless loss of time on account of the knowledge he has acquired and of the studies he has made both at the University course of lectures and as a student in a lawyer's office ;

That, by a resolution dated the eighth day of July, the Board of Notaries has given its consent to the passing of an act authorizing it to admit, at its session, of the month of July, 1903, the said Marie Joseph Norbert René Faribault, to the practice of the notarial profession after examination, provided that at such date he produces a university diploma and a certificate of clerkship from a practising notary showing that he has attended, according to law, the office of such practising notary from the date of his admission to the study of the notarial profession to the date of his examination for admission to the practice of the notarial profession ;

Whereas the said Marie Joseph Norbert René Faribault has prayed that an act be passed for the above purposes, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is authorized to reduce the period of studentship of the said Marie Joseph Norbert René Faribault and to admit him as a notary and to the practice of that profession at the session of the said board in the month of July, 1903, provided that he then produces a university degree in law and a certificate of studentship, showing that he has attended the office of a practising notary from the date of his indentures to the date of his examination for admission to practice, and provided also that he undergoes the required examination for such admission to practice.
