An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Joseph Fortunat Belleau to the practice of medicine and surgery

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

Preamble.

WHEREAS Joseph Fortunat Belleau, bachelor of medicine, of the parish of Ancienne Lorette has, by petition, represented :

That he followed a classical course at the Quebec Seminary as far as rhetoric, inclusively ;

That, owing to a serious illness, his studies were interrupted and he was delayed a year and a half ;

That he entered Laval University in Quebec in 1899, and followed all the lectures of that institution, and, in 1901, obtained a diploma of bachelor of medicine, after passing the examination required by law ;

That his medical studies will be completed in June, 1904, and, without special authorization from this Legislature, he will be prevented from practising his profession and thereby unjustly deprived of the benefit of several years' medical study ;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act to regularize his position, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

Admission of J. F. Belleau as a physician.

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit Joseph Fortunat Belleau, of Ancienne Lorette, amongst its members, and to grant him the necessary license for the practice of medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this province, after having passed the examination required for the degree of doctor at Laval University before the assessors whom the said College of Physicians and Surgeons is hereby authorized to send to represent them.

Coming into force.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
