

## CHAP. 142

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit George Bigué to the practice of medicine and surgery

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

WHEREAS George Bigué, physician and surgeon, of the Preamble. parish of St. Adelphe, county of Champlain, has, by petition, represented :

That he has obtained a diploma of doctor of medicine from Laval University, at Montreal, after having duly followed the course of lectures of the said University for four years ;

That he has followed a complete course of classical studies ;

That he began to follow the course of lectures in medicine before having fully obtained his certificate of admission to the study of medicine, being admitted only as regard letters ;

That, for private reasons beyond his control, he was unable to present himself at the examination on sciences for admission to study ;

That, owing to his not having been duly admitted to the study of medicine, he is exposed to lose the benefit of several years of medical studies and to suffer great loss ;

That there is no practising physician in the parish of St. Adelphe, where the petitioner intends to practise medicine and surgery ;

That it is necessary that the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec be authorized to grant him the license required to practise his profession in the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas the petitioner has prayed that an act be passed to that effect, and it is expedient to grant such prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said George Bigué and to grant him the necessary license to practise medicine, surgery and obstetrics in this province after passing the examination for admission to practice. Admission of G. Bigué as physician.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
