

CHAP. 152

An Act to authorize Albert J. N. Lacaillade to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

WHEREAS Albert J. N. Lacaillade, of the city of Mont- Preamble.
real, has, by his petition, represented :

That he is twenty-six years of age, that he followed a commercial course at Farnham College and a classical course at the Jesuits' College, Montreal ;

That he studied dentistry for five years under Dr. G. Murray, of Lawrence, Massachusetts, a graduate surgeon-dentist of Taft's Medical Schools, Boston, and that he has graduated and obtained his diploma as surgeon-dentist from the Board of Registration in Dentistry of the State of New Hampshire ;

That he practised his profession for two years in the town of Manchester, and one year at Keene, in the State of New York ;

That, through his studies and experience, he possesses all the knowledge and qualifications required of a dentist ;

That he has established his residence in the Province of Quebec, where he desires to continue to reside and practise his profession ;

That he has submitted his application to the Board of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec ;

Whereas he has prayed that an act be passed to authorize him to form part of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to grant to Albert J. N. Lacaillade a license of surgeon-dentist in this province, with all the privileges connected therewith, after examination for admission to practice before the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec.

Admission of A. J. N. Lacaillade as surgeon-dentist.
