An Act to authorize Joseph Stern to practise the profession
of surgeon-dentist in the Province of Quebec

[Assented to 25th April, 1903]

WHEREAS Joseph Stern, of the city of Montreal, has, by Preamble.
his petition, represented :

That, in the year 1897, he entered the Cincinnati College of Dental Surgery, a department of the Ohio State University, in the city of Cincinnati, in the State of Ohio, one of the United States of America ;

That, in the year 1901, he graduated at such university and was duly licensed by the Board of Examiners of the State of Ohio aforesaid to practise the profession of surgeon-dentist in that State ;

That he practised his profession as such in the city of Cincinnati for a period of two years ;

That he was a resident of the city of Montreal for several years prior to pursuing such course of studies at the said city of Cincinnati ;

That he is desirous of taking up his residence in the Province of Quebec and of practising therein the profession of surgeon-dentist ;

That, since the month of September, 1902, he studied dentistry under J. G. Globensky, surgeon-dentist, of the city of Montreal, but that he has not passed the examination for admission to study ;

That, through his studies and experience, he possesses all the necessary knowledge and qualifications to permit him to practise his profession in the Province of Quebec ;

And whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act authorizing him to form part of the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec, and it is expedient to grant his prayer ;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The Dental Association of the Province of Quebec is hereby authorized to grant to Joseph Stern a license to practise dentistry in this province with all the privileges appertaining thereto, after examination for admission to practice before the Dental Association of the Province of Quebec.
