

## C H A P. 10

An Act respecting the registry office of the registration  
division of the county of Wright

[*Assented to 26th March, 1902*]

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows :

1. The delay prescribed for registration under the provisions of section 1 of the act 1 Edward VII, chapter 5, is extended to the thirty-first day of October, 1903. Delay for registration under 1 Ed. VII, c. 5, s. 1, enlarged.
2. The delay for filing the petitions referred to in section 3 of the said act praying for permission to have the registration effected in the case mentioned in section 2 of the same act, shall extend to the thirty-first October, 1903, and, after such date, no petition for obtaining such permission shall be received by the court or judge. Delay for presenting petitions under id. s. 3, enlarged.
3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.

## C H A P. 11

An Act to detach certain townships from the county of Compton and the county of Beauce, and to unite them for the purpose of forming a new county under the name of the county of Lake Megantic, for municipal, judicial, registration and agricultural purposes

[*Assented to 26th March, 1902*]

**W**HEREAS Joseph Napoléon Thibodeau, notary, Adolphe Bécigneul, advocate, Charles Alphonse Léger, merchant tailor, Eusèbe Huard, merchant, John O. McDonald, merchant, all of the village of Megantic, county of Compton, and Louis Napoléon Lapointe, accountant, of the village of Agnes, county of Beauce, have, by their petition, represented, that the too considerable extent of the territory of the two counties of Beauce and Compton, the great number of their inhabitants (sixty-nine thousand, seven hundred and thirty-seven) and the excessive distance of their *chefs-lieux*, greatly hinders the proper administration of these counties in the transaction of public business, causing heavy expense to their inhabitants ;
